KIMBERLEY COAST SAMPLE ITINERARY

Arrive in Kununurra. Accommodation at Freshwater East Kimberley Apartments. Meet your safari pilot to get acquainted.

Day 1 Kununurra to Kimberley Coastal Camp

Rise early and soar over the Ord Irrigation Area, before flying over the huge river systems and coastal properties of Australia's Top End. View the incredible patterns of the Wyndham mud flats and the vast Cambridge Gulf, before reaching the impressive Berkeley River and King George Falls. Arrive at the exquisite Kimberley Coastal Camp, an exclusive retreat offering unrivalled views of the remote Kimberley coastline, an intimate atmosphere and warm, friendly hospitality.

Day 2 Kimberley Coastal Camp

Spend your day fishing for the fabled Barramundi or explore this ancient land on foot or by boat, to experience the local birds, wildlife, and hidden galleries of ancient rock art. You may prefer to take it easy on the boat, cruising to deserted islands fringed by Boab trees, or sipping a cool drink from your poolside day bed. The choices are yours.

Day 3 Kimberley Coastal Camp to Mitchell Falls, Prince Regent River and El Questro

Say farewell to Kimberley Coastal Camp and prepare yourself for the next part of this adventure. Fly towards the Mitchell Plateau where you will orbit the magnificent four-tied Punamii-Uunpuu (Mitchell Falls) before landing at the top. Be guided around the falls by your pilot to experience this incredible natural wonder. From there you will fly to Naturaliste Island, Prince Frederick Harbour, and Careening Bay. Your helicopter allows you the flexibility to land and explore as you wish. As you make your way towards El Questro, enjoy stunnign views of the striking Cockburn Range as they glow in the afternoon sun. Land at El Questro Homestead, perched atop an escarpment that overlooks the Chamberlain River. Take in your beautiful surroundings and enjoy a sunset drink on the Homestead grounds.

Day 4 El Questro

El Questro tours and activities form an integral part of every visit to this stunning wilderness destination. The homestead offers a wide range of complimentary excursions that provide opportunities to fully immerse yourself in the natural attractions of the Wilderness Park. The majority are exclusive to Homestead guests, facilitating engagement between the small group and their guide. El Questro's enthusiastic rangers are adept at personalising your experience to your individual tastes.

Day 5 El Questro to Purnululu National Park (Bungle Bungle), Lake Argyle and Kununurra

Depart from El Questro Homestead and fly south towards the World Heritage-listed Purnululu National Park. Fly over the Bungle Bungle Range, a 350-million-year-old sandstone massif with distinctive black and orange banded beehive-shaped domes. Land at Bellburn Airstrip and be guided through the iconic striped domes and into the natural amphitheatre of Cathedral Gorge. Fly north over the Argyle Diamond Mine where rare pink diamonds were once mined and then discover the vast expanse of Lake Argyle, the largest man-made lake in the Southern KING GEORGE Hemisphere. Complete your BERKELEY KIMBERLEY COASTAL CA spectacular journey by flying VER LODG over the Ord Vallev and back to Kununurra.
